



GREEN New York Marriott Marquis Meeting Package

- Offered to groups of 100 or less
- Use dropcloths in place of linen and skirting (Does not require daily washing)
- All meeting pads and folders are recyclable and made with environmentally friendly glue and vegetable ink
- All pens are made from recycled material and use vegetable ink
- Candy = Yummy earth organic
- Water in glass pitchers
- White boards are used in place of flipcharts, marker refills are biodegradable

GREEN New York Marriott Marquis Meeting Package – Food and Beverage

- All Food and beverage offerings are either organically grown or purchased from local vendors: Coffee, tea, juices, beverages, pastries, dairy, fruit, vegetables, meats, and snacks
- Napkins are made from 100% recycled paper (Earthwise)
- Ecopod Recyclable containers are placed next to all breaks. (All in one recycling container for glass, plastic, aluminum, and paper)
- All food labels are printed on recycled paper
- Label holders are made of reusable birch wood
- All food and beverage offerings are presented on tables requiring no linen
- Decor – Eco-friendly woods, grass, stones, and reusable branches and birch
- Use of bulk condiments on all food and beverage presentations:
 - Sugar
 - Honey
 - Sweetener
 - Butter
- Water and juices are served in large bulk dispensers, rather than bottles

GREEN New York Marriott Marquis Linen Re-use

- Since program roll out in 2005, the NY Marquis has reduced total linen laundry processed annually by **2.3 million lbs**, or **3.7 lbs per occupied room**
- Marriott's Edison NJ Central Laundry has reduced total linen volume by over 11% due to the Linen Reuse program and new bedding package. Edison Laundry has also deployed new technology that reduces water usage by 30%

GREEN New York Marriott Marquis Waste Management

- Cardboard bailing and recycling program
- New city wide Trash vendor provides recycling separation services, trash load reduced 10%
- Fluorescent lamp disposal and recycling system
- SOMAT food waste processing system in The View restaurant; reduction in daily compactor waste load

GREEN MARRIOTT : What we are doing as an organization:

- More than 20 years ago, Marriott embarked on an energy and water conservation campaign.
- The **ECHO (Environmentally Conscious Hospitality Operations)** program has become an industry benchmark for eco-friendly operations. The program expanded to include waste management, wildlife preservation and clean-up projects throughout the world.
- Approximately 275 Marriott hotels have earned the **ENERGY STAR®** label from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for conserving waste, water and energy, the most in the industry
- Marriott International has announced that its global Headquarters building and more than 30 of its hotels in design, development or under construction are expected to achieve **LEED® (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design)** certification from the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC).
- **Actions at HQ:** diverting 64 percent of its total waste (450,000 pounds) from the landfill; shifting to biodegradable disposable containers in its cafeteria, and then ultimately migrating to all permanent-ware; converting used cooking oil into biodiesel fuel; and providing Connect by Hertz cars for employees who use public transportation or carpool to get to the office, but need to run an errand or attend an off-site meeting mid-day.
- Marriott was the first major hotel company in the U.S. with a LEED certified hotel-- The Inn and Conference Center by Marriott at the University of Maryland.
- Marriott was the first hotel company to join the USGBC in 2007, 20 of its Architecture and Construction associates will be LEED-accredited by year-end.

GREEN Global:

- The Portland Marriott Downtown Waterfront, the Portland Marriott City Center and the Philadelphia Airport Marriott are certified by Green Seal, a non-profit organization that provides science-based environmental certification standards.
- The Newcastle Marriott and Manchester Marriott in the United Kingdom, the Sydney Marriott and Melbourne Marriott in Australia, and the Okinawa Marriott in Japan are certified by Green Globe, the premier international brand for sustainable travel.
- The Dearborn Inn, Detroit Marriott Troy and the Detroit Marriott Livonia in Michigan have been certified by Green Lodging Michigan.
- The Calgary Marriott Hotel in Canada earned a "4 Green Key" rating through the Hotel Association of Canada's (HAC) Green Key Eco-Rating Program.
- Surfers Paradise Marriott Resort & Spa in Australia was named a "Sustainable Hotel" at the Hotel Investment Conference.

GREEN Energy Conservation since 2000:

- Marriott HQ has become waste neutral
- Smoke free initiative - 30% HVAC energy savings
- Linen reuse - 17% water savings
- 450,000 fluorescent light bulbs - 65% energy savings
- 400,000 low-flow showerheads - 10% water savings
- Low-flow toilets - 46% water savings

GREEN New York Marriott Marquis – we are Proud to Conserve Energy and it Shows:

- Lighting Retrofit, **793,300 KWH reduction**, 2006
- Major Re-Commissioning of building mechanical and ventilation systems, **Electricity consumption reduced 3%, Steam consumption reduced 16%, Water consumption reduced 9%**, 2006-2007
- All Guest Rooms re-lamped with Compact Fluorescent Lamps every 2 years
- Automatic Faucets installed in Public Restrooms
